<b>Abbeydale Brewery</b> Moonshine	<i>Sheffield</i> 4.3% abv	Hopped with Wallamette, Delta, Citra, Chinook & Centennial - this is a beautifully well balanced pale perfect for any occasion
<b>Away Days Beers</b> Ale N Shearer	<i>Newark</i> 4.9% abv	Pale ale with citrus aroma and a clean finish making it a great session ale.
<b>The Beer Studio</b> Moroccan Gold	<i>Salford</i> 4.7% abv	A gorgeous beer with high levels of bitterness that reflect the crisp air of the Atlas Mountains and a resinous, citrus flavour that mirror the scents of the forested areas of the country.
<b>Black Tor Brewery</b> Tap Tackle	<i>Exeter</i> 4.0% abv	Easy drinking amber ale brewed for The Rugby World Cup 2019, malty and fruity with smooth bitterness and hints of caramel.
<b>Burton Bridge Brewery</b> Golden Delicious	<i>Burton-on-Trent</i> 3.8% abv	Pale straw, delicate hop aroma with a dry bitter finish.
<b>8 Sail Brewery</b> Merry Miller	<i>Sleaford</i> 4.1% abv	Traditional copper coloured bitter with a nutty, malty flavour and a balanced finish.
<b>Elland Brewery</b> White Prussion	<i>Elland, Yorkshire</i> 3.9% abv	A crisp, clean and refreshing beer made from lager malt and German hops. A fruity flavour with a floral, spice and citrus aroma from Perle and Mittlefruh hops.
<b>Elland Brewery</b> Nettle Thrasher	<i>Elland, Yorkshire</i> 4.4% abv	A copper flavoursome ale, complex and fruity. Made from a combination of six malts, complimented with English Challenger and Bramling Cross hops to give a smooth fruity character and delicate blackcurrant aroma.
<b>Great Newsome Brewery</b> Honkers Saddler	<i>Hull</i> 5.0% abv	Classic style bitter, loads of bitterness but well balanced with a fruity, herbal aroma.

<b>Lord's Brewing Company</b> Chosen Man	<i>Sheffield</i> 4.4% abv	Having the malt character of a traditional bitter, with hints of caramel and a toasted edge, with New World hops giving a twist to a classic style. Faintly citrus with a lovely pininess and a gentle floral character .
<b>Orkney Brewery</b> Northern Light	<i>Orkney</i> 4.0% abv	Refreshing citrus flavours dominate the palate with hints of Brioche and fresh bread, giving way to a clean refreshing hoppy aftertaste.
<b>Ossett Brewing Ltd</b> Silver King	<i>South Ossett</i> 4.3% abv	A crisp dry bitter with a citrus finish.
<b>Pennine Brewing Co.</b> Amber Necker	<i>Bedale</i> 3.8% abv	A sparkling session beer brewed with both English and American Hops to give a smooth and creamy texture with a hoppy after-taste.

<b>Farmer Jims</b> Farmyard Perry	<i>Devon</i> 4.5% abv	A light fruity Perry made from proper Perry Pears.

### Gins

<b>Aber Falls Orange Marmalade</b> Wales 41.3% abv		A refined balance of sweet and bitter orange flavours: a citrus hit with a warming aftertaste.
<b>Arrowsmiths Ruby Rhubarb</b> England 37.5% abv		Created using an old family recipe from 1923, this gin encompasses wonderfully balanced sweet and tart flavours from carefully hand selected English ruby rhubarb, delicately infused with finely pressed elderflower.
<b>Cross Keys Single Batch</b> Latvia 41% abv		This authentic and complex gin represents the 'true spirit of the Baltic states'. Camomile, blossom, rosemary and juniper tones dance on the pallet, creating an aromatic, sweet flavour - reminiscent of warm baltic summers.
<b>Daffy's Small Batch Premium</b> Scotland 43.4% abv		The adventure started with the discovery of what Lebanese mint can bring to the finest gin. Carefully balanced with 8 other botanicals and bottled with the finest Scottish water.
<b>Dictador Ortodoxy Colombian</b> Colombia 43% abv		Based on the personal formula of the company's former president. After visiting the UK he created his own Colombian gin. A glorious recipe, rich with juniper, angelica and mint notes which is aged in used rum barrels
<b>Herno Gin</b> Sweden 40.5% abv		Multi award-winning gin with Scandinavian botanicals from the first dedicated gin distillery in Sweden.
<b>Hoxton Pink</b> England 40% abv		A premium gin, with naturally and ethically sourced ingredients, including Juniper, Gunpowder Tea, Rosehip, Rose, Bergamot, Grapefruit, Orris, Liquorice, Camomile, Elderflower and Hibiscus Sugar.
<b>Jin-Dea Single Estate Tea</b> France 40% abv		The key botanical is a Darjeeling black tea. Partnered with juniper, lemon, grapefruit, coriander, ginger, fennel, cardamom, cinnamon and angelica, the resulting gin plays with a hint of spice alongside the fragrant tea notes.
<b>Lola y Vera Strawberry</b> Spain 40% abv		A handcrafted, Spanish strawberry gin made without preservatives, sweeteners or artificial colours. A little baking spice percolates through red berry sweetness and a little anise.
<b>Mombassa Club Lemon Edition</b> Spain 37.5% abv		Rich and warming lemon is tempered by bold and warm spices and creamy angelica.
<b>No. 209</b> USA 46% abv		This five times distilled Gin is beautifully aromatic with lots of citrus and floral scents and a hint of spiciness.
<b>Porters Tropical Old Tom</b> Scotland 40% abv		A classic Old Tom recipe lifted by tropical notes of passion fruit, guava and white tea.
<b>Seven Hills</b> Italy 43% abv		This taste of Italy is made using a combination of seven botanicals - juniper, celery, rose hip, artichoke, blood orange, chamomile and pomegranate.
<b>Sharish Blue Magic</b> Portugal 40% abv		Exceptionally smooth with a fruity aroma and citrus taste. The botanicals include Juniper, Cinnamon, Coriander Seeds, Clove, Vanilla, and totally fresh Orange Peel, Lemon Peel, Bravo Esmolfe Apple and Lemon verbena.
<b>Sir Robin of Locksley No. 61</b> England 40.5% abv		A blend of traditional botanicals with more delicate infusions of elderflower, dandelion and pink grapefruit.
<b>Ungava</b> Canada 43.1% abv		Named after a peninsular in northern Quebec , this intriguing gin is made using rare, hand-picked botanicals include Nordic Juniper, Arctic Blend, Cloudberry, Crowberry, Labrador Tea and Wild Rose Hips.
