<b>B&amp;T</b> Plum Mild	<i>Shefford, Bedfordshire</i> 3.8% abv	A rich dark mild with strong malt aroma and hints of plum porter
<b>Black Hole</b> No Escape	<i>Burton-on-Trent</i> 5.2% abv	A combination of chocolate, crystal and roasted barley produce subtle, smooth flavours in this award winning beer
<b>Brew York</b> Jarsa	<i>York</i> 3.7% abv	Juicy and refreshing session ale
<b>Brewsters</b> Hop A Doodle Doo	<i>Grantham, Lincs</i> 4.3% abv	Copper brew in style of APA with light roast malts and fruity hop character
<b>Brunswick</b> Rocket	<i>Derby</i> 4.7% abv	New world IPA, hopped with Ella, Summer and Cascade
<b>Castle Rock</b> Elsie Mo	<i>Nottingham</i> 4.7% abv	A golden ale that tempts you with its aroma and pleasantly crisp aftertaste
<b>Charnwood</b> Tipping Point	<i>Loughborough</i> 4.2% abv	Six different grains harvest a wonderful light red coloured beer for this early autumnal ale
<b>Dancing Duck</b> Quack Addict	<i>Derby</i> 3.8% abv	Deep chestnut with a malty character, spicy molasses and blackcurrant notes
<b>Glenn Ackerman</b> Witham Gold	<i>Coggeshall</i> 4.1% abv	Refreshing golden ale
<b>Green Duck</b> Close Action	<i>Stourbridge</i> 4.5% abv	Loads of mosaic hops means loads of fruitiness, flavours of mango, pine and papaya
<b>Gun Dog</b> Hot Dog	<i>Daventry</i> 3.9% abv	Refreshing golden summer ale with hints of a citrus aroma
<b>Kelham Island</b> Zombies of the Stratosphere	<i>Sheffield</i> 4.8% abv	Refreshing background sweetness, herbal and pine aromas

<b>Rudgate</b> Viking	<i>Tockwith, York</i> 3.8% abv	Award winning full bodied beer with hops and fruit complimenting the flavour
<b>Salopian</b> Treasure Trove	<i>Hadnall, Shresbury</i> 4.0% abv	A fruity golden ale with a sensuous citrus finish
<b>Sherwood Outlaws</b> Outlaws Bitter	<i>Doncaster</i> 4.0% abv	Slightly malty bitter with biscuit notes
<b>Springhead</b> Drop of the Black Stuff	<i>Laneham, Doncaster</i> 4.0% abv	Stunning Porter, ominously dark but not heavy, lingering finish of roasted barley
<b>Steamin' Billy</b> Skydiver	<i>Leicester</i> 5.0% abv	Mahogany coloured bitter, full of character and very moreish
<b>Tickety Brew</b> Blonde	<i>Stalybridge, Ashton-Under-Lyme</i> 5.6% abv	A classic Belgian beer, full of flavour
<b>Tiny Rebel</b> Cwtch	<i>Newport</i> 4.6% abv	Welsh red ale with caramel and citrus flavours. Champion beer of Britain 2015
<b>Totally Brewed</b> Crazy Like A Fox	<i>Nottingham</i> 4.5% abv	A traditional English style bitter
<b>Welbeck Abbey</b> Duck Decoy	<i>Worksop</i> 4.6% abv	An American hopped zesty pale ale
<b>White Horse</b> Village Idiot	<i>Stanford in the Vale</i> 4.1% abv	A refreshingly clean bitter beer, with fine pale malt and a touch of wheat for a fine balance
