No.	Name	ABV	Country/ Region	Tasting Notes
1	Amazzoni Gin Maniuara	38%	Brazil	A delightfully zesty and gently sweet Old Tom Gin from Brazil. Following double distillation, an array of botanicals are then cold infused before generous helpings of lemon skins and lemongrass are allowed to macerate.
2	Bobby's Schiedam	42%	Holland	Made with a combination of local and exotic ingredients, including juniper, clove, lemongrass, cubeb peppers and rosehips. Highlighting the meeting of Dutch and Indonesian flavours in the spirit. Floral as it opens with fresh rose, followed by a hint of red berry sweetness. Coriander gives it a fragrant spice throughout.
3	Greater Than Broken Bat Gin	47%	India	Cricket bats are among the botanicals used in this aged gin. Yep, you read that right. Cricket bats! The result is a characterful but balanced gin, with perfumed wood, vanilla, and sweet spice notes alongside the juniper core.
4	Tarsier Lychee & Raspberry Oriental Pink Gin	40%	Stockport	This pink spirit was inspired by the founders' travels around Southeast Asia. Raspberries and red dragon fruit are distilled alongside galangal, calamansi (a variety of lime) and seven traditional botanicals. After distillation, raspberry and lychee are infused into the spirit, giving it a pink hue.
5	Boë Passion	41.5%	Scotland	Terrifically tangy passion fruit-flavoured gin from Scotland's Boë. A mixture of fresh passion fruit and bright orange notes meld with classic herbaceous gin elements.
6	Hayman's Gently Rested	41.3%	London	A sophisticated new edition to reflect the style of gin sold in London's ornate Gin Palaces in the 1800s when gin was sold straight from the cask. First distilled by hand before being rested in Scotch whisky casks for just three weeks. This brief wood contact adds nuance and individuality to an already wonderful dry gin.
7	Condessa Prickly Pear & Orange Blossom	43%	Mexico	A gin from Mexico City, this edition from Condesa is infused with prickly pear (which tastes like a cross between watermelon and kiwi) and orange blossom, alongside raspberry, lime, and other botanicals. It was created to capture the essence of golden hour in Mexico springtime,
8	Café del Mar	40%	Ibiza	Created for sunset sipping, this gin celebrates Ibiza's famous Café del Mar. With a core of juniper, backed by fresh citrus and sweet spice, it's a smooth, sumptuous and subtly balanced spirit.
9	G'Vine June Peach & Summer Fruits	37.5%	France	This flavoured gin liqueur from G'Vine was made with peaches and summer fruits to create a drink just made to enjoyed in the sunshine with a tonic water and good company. Stone fruit, strawberry, citrus, and bright floral notes.
10	Hoxton Tropical Gin	40%	London	Coconut and grapefruit are accompanied by ginger, tarragon and orris. Bright, tropical and unmistakably Hoxton, with soft citrus and a clean, refreshing finish.
11	Turner's Apple Gin	40%	Kent	The makers of Turners Cider in Kent know their apples having produced many award-winning ciders. Now they have harnessed the spirit of Kentish apples to create this crisp, classic London Dry gin.
12	Ginato Clementino	38%	Italy	Tannic notes of red grape and a hint of rose, alongside fragrant piney juniper and sweet citrus running throughout.
13	Papa Salt Coastal Gin	42.8%	Australia	This is the brainchild of superstar Margo Robbie, her husband and their friends. It was developed in partnership with Lord Byron Distillery in Byron Bay and features Australian botanicals like wattleseed, wax flower, and oyster shell.
14	Brockman's Orange Kiss	40%	Surrey	The distillery went to the trouble of making its own triple sec, which it uses as a botanical here alongside Valencia oranges, juniper, almond oil, and coriander. Sweet citrus is tempered by zestier notes, with a strong juniper backbone and just a prickle of spice.
15	Aztec Premium Gin	40%	Wales	A vibrant dry gin, drawing inspiration from sacred Aztec botanicals. Cacao nibs, avocado leaves, and epazote (also known as Mexican tea) join the likes of juniper, coriander, and citrus for a gin that's layered with herbal elegance and earthy, aromatic depth.
16	Bareksten Double Gin	43%	Norway	This vibrant gin is made by distilling juniper by itself, and distilling eight other botanicals together, and then blending them together. Hence, Double Gin. Orange peel and elderflower brightness, with earthy juniper spiciness building underneath.
17	Carmela Gin - Guayaba & Mango	37.5%	Canary Islands	Sweet, juicy mango and syrupy guava mingle with delicate florals, citrus zest, and a prickle of peppery juniper. A deliciously tropical taste of the Canary Islands, Carmela Gin is brimming with exotic flavours.
18	Roku Sakura Bloom	43%	Japan	This limited edition gin from Japanese producer Roku celebrates the transient beauty of Sakura flowers with a combo of six uniquely Japanese botanicals. Delicate florals ride throughout with notes of cherry blossom, fresh herbs, and vibrant juniper.
19	Ginato Pompelmo	38%	Italy	Candied peels and tangy grapefruit flesh, creamy hints of vanilla and peach, supported by crisp juniper and peppercorn.
20	Tarquin's Rhubarb & Raspberry	38%	Cornwall	Tart red berry, backed up by floral juniper, angelica and violet. A good helping of cinnamon brings a spicy kick to the mid-palate, offering balance to the rhubarb and raspberry.
21	Sipsmith Lemon Drizzle	40.4%	London	Fresh, tart and warming, the lemon is powerful, but is tempered well by savoury juniper, a pang of liquorice and a floral perfume quality that lifts it.
22	Copeland Jones 1778 Navy Strength	57%	Ireland	A Navy strength, cask-aged gin named after John Paul Jones, a well-known naval commander from the American Revolutionary War. The gin was first aged in Kentucky Bourbon casks for 120 days, before being moved over to Oloroso sherry casks for another 20 days, and then bottled at 57% ABV.
23	Chief Gowanus New-Netherland Gin	44%	USA	A Dutch gin by way of America with a 19th century rye whiskey based recipe discovered by drinks historian Dr. David Wondrich. Spicy rye and Cluster hops come through, along with the juniper, but the cask maturation has done its job. There are no sharp edges here. Blueberries, Jelly Babies, pepper and anise develop.
24	Amontillado Cask-Aged Gin (Lost Parcels)	42.8%	England (various locations*)	This is a gin that spent 19 months slumbering in a cask that previously held amontillado sherry, imparting rich layers of candied nuts and orange peels to the oily juniper at its core. The finish has a gentle hint if vanilla, toasted nuts and soft oak. A release of just 53 bottles.
25	Mallows' Chocolate, Chilli & Sea Salt	40%	Wales	This is for those of you who love exploring exciting flavour combinations. Alongside the classic core of juniper, this one also features the likes of chocolate, chilli, and sea salt! There's sweet notes, savoury notes, spicy notes, all in one sip.
26	Beefeater 24	45%	London	A recent addition to the Beefeater range with no less than 12 ingredients: Japanese Sencha Tea, Chinese green tea, Seville orange peel, grapefruit peel, lemon peel, juniper, coriander seed, liquorice, angelica root, almond and orris root. The result is a fragrant gin with good sweetness.
27	Mr White's Gin	40%	Worcester	Created by chef Marco Pierre White this gin takes a stripped-back, ingredient-first approach to flavour. Distilled with juniper, coriander, cardamom and orris root for classic depth, it layers in lavender for a floral lift, fresh lemon peel, fresh orange peel, lemon verbena for a herbal edge, and liquorice root for a gentle earthy sweetness, delivering a gin that's crisp, elegant, and balanced.
28	Polarity Light	40%	London	Delicate ironwort and apple sweet chamomile sit ahead of earthy elfdock and two juniper varieties, while the distinct savoury snaps back with a peppery bite.
29	Orkney Gin Co. Rhubarb Old Tom	43%	Orkney	A tangy twist on Old Tom gin made with rhubarb grown in Orkney! The classic sweetness of Old Tom complements the zesty tartness of herbaceous perennial, with all of this carried on the delightfully creamy seven-times-distilled wheat spirit.
30	Kopparberg Passion Fruit & Orange	37.5%	Sweden	This premium gin is based one a classic London Dry base expertly infused with passionfruit and orange to serve you a London Dry Style Gin with an exotic touch.
